The Board of Professional Conduct files a final certified report with the Supreme Court of Ohio. The report includes findings of fact, the board's recommendation as to whether an attorney or judge has violated the Code of Judicial Conduct and the Rules of Professional Conduct, and the appropriate sanction to be imposed.

The Court issues a show cause order providing both relator and respondent 20 days to file objections to the recommendation and a brief in support. An answer to objections must be filed within 15 days of the filing of the objections.
