DISCIPLINARY DOCKET

96-638. In re Judicial Campaign Complaint Against Emrich. This case was filed pursuant to Gov. Jud. R. II(5). On June 17, 1996, the five-judge commission (the "Commission of Judges") that this court appointed to consider this matter issued its final order.

According to Gov. Jud. R. II(4)(E)(2), the respondent may appeal the decision of the Commission of Judges as provided in Gov. Jud. R. III(3). That section provides that notice of appeal shall be given by the respondent to the Commission of Judges and to the Supreme Court within twenty days of the respondent's receipt by certified mail of the findings of the Commission of Judges.

According to the records of this court, the respondent received the findings of the Commission of Judges by certified mail on June 21, 1996. Whereas respondent's notice of appeal, due no later than July 11, 1996, was filed on July 15, 1996,

IT IS ORDERED by the court that respondent's appeal to this court from the order of the Commission of Judges be, and hereby is, dismissed as untimely.
