**98-2110. Leisure v. State Farm Auto. Ins. Co.**

Stark App. Nos. 1997CA00417 and 1998CA00001. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Stark County.

IT IS ORDERED by the court, *sua sponte*, that oral argument scheduled for December 14, 1999, be continued until further order of the court.

**98-2481. Leisure v. State Farm Auto. Ins. Co.**

Stark App. Nos. 1997CA00420 and 1997CA00445. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Stark County.

IT IS ORDERED by the court, *sua sponte*, that oral argument scheduled for December 14, 1999, be continue until further order of the court.

**99-764. State v. Worthy.**

Portage App. No. 97-P-0059. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Portage County. Upon consideration of the motion of *amicus curiae*, Ohio Attorney General Betty D. Montgomery, participate in oral argument scheduled for January 12, 2000,

**99-1659. State ex rel. Messina v. Steiner.**

In Mandamus. This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of mandamus. Upon consideration of relator's motion for emergency stay of the Licking County Court of Common Pleas proceedings,

Upon consideration of appellant's motion for stay of further execution of sentence and motion for bail pending determination of appeal,
