MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2001-0253. State v. Bryan.

Cuyahoga C.P. No. CR393660. This cause came on for further consideration upon appellant's motion for stay of execution pending exhaustion of state remedies. Upon consideration thereof,

IT IS ORDERED by the court that the motion for stay of execution be, and hereby is, granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by the court that this stay shall remain in effect until exhaustion of all state post-conviction proceedings, including any appeals.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that counsel for the appellant and for the appellee shall notify this court when all proceedings for post-conviction relief before courts of this state have been exhausted.

2003-2142. State ex rel. Lewis v. Collins.

In Mandamus. This cause came on for further consideration upon relator's motion to compromise and dismiss action pursuant to Supreme Court Rule XIV(6)(E). Upon consideration thereof,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by the court that the motion be, and hereby is, denied as moot.

2004-0107. State ex rel. Youngstown/Mahoning Cty. Convention & Visitors' Bur., Inc. v. Tablack.

In Mandamus. This cause originated in this court upon the filing of a complaint for a writ of mandamus. Upon consideration of the joint motion for extension of time to file evidence pursuant to S.Ct.Prac.R. XIV(6)(C),

IT IS ORDERED by the court that the motion for extension of time be, and hereby is, granted, and that the parties' evidence be due on or before June 1, 2004. All other aspects of this court's April 28, 2004 entry remain in effect.

2004-0413. State ex rel. Rowe v. Indus. Comm.

Franklin App. No. 03AP-181, 2004-Ohio-587. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Franklin County. Upon consideration of appellant's motion for extension of time to file merit brief pursuant to S.Ct.Prac.R. XIV(6)(C),

IT IS ORDERED by the court that the motion for extension of time be, and hereby is, granted, and that appellant's merit brief be due on or before June 9, 2004.

MISCELLANEOUS DISMISSALS

2004-0307. State ex rel. Holdren v. Indus. Comm.

Franklin App. No. 03AP-164, 2003-Ohio-7230. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Franklin County. It appears from the records of this court that appellant has not filed a merit brief, due May 17, 2004, in compliance with the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court and therefore has failed to prosecute this cause with the requisite diligence. Upon consideration thereof,

IT IS ORDERED by the court that this cause be, and hereby is, dismissed sua sponte.

2004-0559. Auction Properties, Inc. v. Columbiana Cty. Bd. of Revision.

Board of Tax Appeals, No. 2003-G-183. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Board of Tax Appeals. It appears from the records of this court that appellant has not filed a merit brief, due May 18, 2004, in compliance with the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court and therefore has failed to prosecute this cause with the requisite diligence. Upon consideration thereof,

IT IS ORDERED by the court that this cause be, and hereby is, dismissed sua sponte.

2004-0694. Chillicothe v. Arrowood.

Ross App. No. 03CA2706. This cause is pending before the court as a discretionary appeal and claimed appeal of right. It appears from the records of the court that the appellant has not filed a memorandum in support of jurisdiction, due May 17, 2004, in compliance with the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court and therefore has failed to prosecute this cause with the requisite diligence. Upon consideration thereof,

IT IS ORDERED by the court that this cause be, and hereby is, dismissed sua sponte.
