## MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

### **2004-1325. State v. Chandler.**

Stark App. No. 2003-CA-00342, 2004-Ohio-3436. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Stark County. Upon consideration of the joint motion to allow amicus curiae, Ohio Attorney General Jim Petro, to participate in oral argument scheduled for September 20, 2005, in support of the appellant,

IT IS ORDERED by the court that the motion is granted, and amicus curiae shall share the time allotted to appellant.

### **2004-1619. Valentine v. PPG Industries, Inc.**

Pickaway App. No. 03CA17, 2004-Ohio-4521. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Pickaway County. Upon consideration of the motion of amicus curiae, Ohio Attorney General, Jim Petro, to participate in oral argument scheduled for September 21, 2005, as amicus curiae supporting neither party,

IT IS ORDERED by the court that the motion is denied because it does not meet the standard set forth in S.Ct.Prac.R. IX(6)(A).

### **2004-1746. State v. Bledsoe.**

Stark App. No. 2003-CA-00403, 2004-Ohio-4764. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Stark County. Upon consideration of the joint motion to allow amicus curiae, Ohio Attorney General Jim Petro, to participate in oral argument scheduled for September 20, 2005, in support of the appellant,

IT IS ORDERED by the court that the motion is granted, and amicus curiae shall share the time allotted to appellant.

**2005-1086. State ex rel. Cleveland Hts.-University Hts. City School Dist. v. Cuyahoga Cty. Bd. of Elections.**

Cuyahoga App. No. 85528. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Cuyahoga County. Upon consideration of appellants' motions for expedited consideration and for issuance of peremptory writ of mandamus, and appellee Cuyahoga County Board of Elections' motion for denial of appellants' merit brief,

IT IS ORDERED by the court that the motions are denied.
