RECONSIDERATION OF PRIOR DECISIONS

2007-1265. Jefferson v. Beightler.

Marion App. No. 9-07-10. Reported at ___ Ohio St.3d ___, 2007-Ohio-4689, ___ N.E.2d ___. On motion for reconsideration. Motion denied.

DISCIPLINARY CASES

2006-0079. Cincinnati Bar Assn. v. Lukey.

On application for reinstatement of Paul E. Lukey, Attorney Registration No. 0000965. Application granted and respondent reinstated to the practice of law in Ohio.

2007-0621. In re Resignation of Macejko.

On affidavit of resignation from the practice of law of Theodore Thomas Macejko, Attorney Registration No. 0010642, and on report filed under seal by Disciplinary Counsel. Resignation accepted with disciplinary action pending.

It is further ordered, sua sponte, that all documents filed with this court in this case shall meet the filing requirements set forth in the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio, including requirements as to form, number, and timeliness of filings.
