MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2008-0033. Northeast Ohio Psychiatric Inst. v. Levin.

Board of Tax Appeals, No. 2005-M-1683. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Board of Tax Appeals. Upon consideration of the motion for leave of amici curiae Ohio School Boards Association, Ohio Association of School Business Officials, and Buckeye Association of School Administrators to participate in oral argument scheduled for Wednesday, November 19, 2008, in support of appellee,

It is ordered by the court that the motion is granted and amici curiae shall share the time allotted to appellee.

2008-2197. Countrywide Home Loans, Inc. v. Huff.

Trumbull App. No. 2007-T-0121, 2008-Ohio-4974. This cause is pending before the court as a discretionary appeal and claimed appeal of right. Upon consideration of appellants' motion to stay foreclosure,

It is ordered by the court that the motion is denied.
