2008-0315. Meyer v. United Parcel Service, Inc.

Hamilton App. No. C-060772, 174 Ohio App.3d 339, 2007-Ohio-7063. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Hamilton County. Upon consideration of appellant/cross-appellee's motion for continuance of oral argument,

It is ordered by the court that the motion is denied.

2008-1133. Hodesh v. Korelitz.

Hamilton App. Nos. C-0700172, C-0700168, C-061040, and C-061013, 2008-Ohio-2052. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Hamilton County. Upon consideration of the motion of ProAssurance Company to withdraw from the appeal,

It is ordered by the court that the motion is granted.

Board of Tax Appeals, Nos. 2006-M-206 and 2006-M-207. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Board of Tax Appeals. Upon consideration of appellant's request for oral argument before the full court,

Champaign App. No. 2006 CA 23, 2007-Ohio-6698. On August 11, 2008, appellant filed a notice of pending motion to certify a conflict. Whereas appellant has not notified this court of the decision on the pending motion to certify a conflict,

It is ordered by the court, sua sponte, that appellant show cause within 14 days of the date of this entry why this court should not proceed to consider the jurisdictional memoranda in this appeal pursuant to S.Ct.Prac.R. III(6).

2008-2087. Mid-Wood, Inc. v. Worthington.

Wood App. No. WD-08-036. This cause is pending before the court as a discretionary appeal and claimed appeal of right. On October 27, 2008, when this appeal was filed, a check in the amount of \$40 was submitted by appellant to satisfy the requirement of the docket fee imposed by R.C. 2503.17 and S.Ct.Prac.R. XV(1). This court has been informed by the Office of the Treasurer

of the State of Ohio that the check was returned because of insufficient funds. Whereas R.C. 2503.17 and S.Ct.Prac.R. XV(1), require that the docket fee shall be paid before a notice of appeal is filed or a case is docketed,

It is ordered by the court, sua sponte, that this cause is dismissed.
