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## MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

### **2012-1971. Gallenstein v. Levin.**

Board of Tax Appeals, No. 2008-A-1340. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Board of Tax Appeals.

Upon consideration of appellant's motion for continuance of the August 7, 2013 oral argument before a master commissioner, it is ordered by the court that the motion is granted. Oral argument before a master commissioner is rescheduled for August 28, 2013.

## DISCIPLINARY CASES

### **1992-2535. Cincinnati Bar Assn. v. Smith.**

On June 19, 2013, respondent, Timothy A. Smith, filed an application for termination of probation. Upon consideration thereof, the court finds that respondent has substantially complied with Gov.Bar R. V(9)(D) and with its order dated August 11, 1993, in which the court suspended respondent from the practice of law for a period of one year, with the entire suspension stayed, and placed respondent on monitored probation for one year.

On consideration thereof, it is ordered by this court that the probation of respondent, Timothy A. Smith, Attorney Registration No. 0032087, last known business address in Cincinnati, Ohio, is terminated.

It is further ordered that the clerk of this court issue certified copies of this order as provided for in Gov.Bar R. V(8)(D)(1), that publication be made as provided for in Gov.Bar R. V(8)(D)(2), and that respondent bear the costs of publication.

**2011-2046. Disciplinary Counsel v. Alexander.**

On application for reinstatement of James Alexander Jr., Attorney Registration No. 0033384. Application granted and respondent is reinstated to the practice of law in Ohio, with a one-year monitored probation.
