## MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

**2013-0118. Jarvis v. First Resolution Invest. Corp.**

Summit App. No. 26042, 2012-Ohio-5653. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Summit County.

Upon consideration of the motion for admission pro hac vice of Mariam Morshedi, it is ordered by the court that the motion is granted. Pursuant to Gov.Bar R. XII(4), counsel shall file a notice of permission to appear pro hac vice with the Supreme Court's Office of Attorney Services within 30 days of the date of this entry.

**2013-0431. Williams v. Matthews.**

Cuyahoga App. No. 98136, 2013-Ohio-483. This cause is pending before the court as a jurisdictional appeal.

Upon consideration of appellant's motion to file the case under seal, it is ordered by the court that the motion is denied.

**2013-0796. State v. Campbell.**

Franklin C.P. No. 97CR-04-2020. This cause is pending before the court as a death-penalty appeal from the Court of Common Pleas of Franklin County.

Upon consideration of appellant's motion for an extension of time to transmit the record, it is ordered by the court that the motion is granted. The record shall be filed no later than September 18, 2013.

**2013-1227. Keller v. Dundon.**

Licking App. No. 12-CA-73, 2013-Ohio-2727. This cause is pending before the court as a jurisdictional appeal.

Upon consideration of the motions for admission pro hac vice of Steven L. Boldt and Austin W. Bartlett, it is ordered by the court that the motions are granted. Pursuant to Gov.Bar R. XII(4), counsel shall file notices of permission to appear pro hac vice with the Supreme Court's Office of Attorney Services within 30 days of the date of this entry.

**2013-1204. State ex rel. Toledo Blade Co. v. Toledo.**

Lucas App. No. L-12-1183, 2013-Ohio-3094. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Lucas County.
