### **2012-2098. In re Comm. Rev. of Capacity Charges of Ohio Power Co.**

Public Utilities Commission, No. 10-2929-EL-UNC. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal and cross-appeal from the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio.

Upon consideration of the motions for admission pro hac vice of Jeffrey A. Lamken and Martin V. Totaro, it is ordered by the court that the motions are granted. Pursuant to Gov.Bar R. XII(4), counsel shall file notices of permission to appear pro hac vice with the Supreme Court's Office of Attorney Services within 30 days of the date of this entry.

### **2013-0228. In re Comm. Rev. of Capacity Charges of Ohio Power Co.**

Public Utilities Commission, No. 10-2929-EL-UNC. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal and cross-appeal from the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio.

Upon consideration of the motions for admission pro hac vice of Jeffrey A. Lamken and Martin V. Totaro, it is ordered by the court that the motions are granted. Pursuant to Gov.Bar R. XII(4), counsel shall file notices of permission to appear pro hac vice with the Supreme Court's Office of Attorney Services within 30 days of the date of this entry.

### **2013-0459. Auer v. Paliath.**

Montgomery App. No. 25158, 2013-Ohio-391. This cause is pending before the court as a jurisdictional appeal.

Upon consideration of the motion for admission pro hac vice of Ralph W. Holmen and Katherine R. Johnson, it is ordered by the court that the motion is granted. Pursuant to Gov.Bar R. XII(4), counsel shall file a notice of permission to appear pro hac vice with the Supreme Court's Office of Attorney Services within 30 days of the date of this entry.

### **2013-0796. State v. Campbell.**

Franklin C.P. No. 97CR-04-2020. This cause is pending before the court as a death-penalty appeal from the Court of Common Pleas of Franklin County.

As appellant has already had one direct appeal of right to this court in case No. 2001-1057, *State v. Campbell*, it is ordered by the court, sua sponte, that appellant shall show cause within 20 days of the date of this entry why this appeal should not be dismissed. Appellee shall file a response within ten days of appellant's filing of his response to this order.
