MERIT DECISIONS WITH OPINIONS

2013-0221. Mahoning Cty. Bar Assn. v. Wagner, Slip Opinion No. 2013-Ohio-5087.

On Certified Report by the Board of Commissioners on Grievances and Discipline, No. 12-023. Respondent, Michael James Wagner, Attorney Registration No. 0016371, is indefinitely suspended from the practice of law in Ohio, with credit granted for the time served under the January 24, 2012 interim suspension.

2013-0230. Cleveland Metro. Bar Assn. v. Wrentmore, Slip Opinion No. 2013-Ohio-5041.

On Certified Report by the Board of Commissioners on Grievances and Discipline, No. 11-093. James Clarence Wrentmore, Attorney Registration No. 0046779, is indefinitely suspended from the practice of law in Ohio.

MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

In re Catudal.

On September 11, 2013, this court prohibited Chance Catudal from continuing or instituting any affidavit-of-disqualification proceedings relating to *Catudal v. Catudal*, case No. 00DR-004934, without first obtaining leave. On November 12, 2013, Catudal presented a motion for leave to file an affidavit of disqualification.

It is ordered that the motion for leave is denied.

2013-1222. King v. Wachauf.

Auglaize App. No. 2-12-10, 2013-Ohio-2498. This cause is pending before the court as a jurisdictional appeal.

Upon consideration of appellee Hamilton Mutual Insurance Company's motion to strike memorandum in support of jurisdiction, it is ordered by the court that the motion is denied as moot.

2013-1746. Felix v. Ganley Chevrolet, Inc.

Cuyahoga App. No. 98985, 2013-Ohio-3523. This cause is pending before the court as a jurisdictional appeal.

Upon consideration of the motion for admission pro hac vice of Cary Silverman, it is ordered by the court that the motion is granted. Pursuant to Gov.Bar R. XII(4), counsel shall file a notice of permission to appear pro hac vice with the Supreme Court's Office of Attorney Services within 30 days of the date of this entry.

DISCIPLINARY CASES

2013-1803. In re Jackson.

On certified entry of felony conviction. Harry Earl Jackson, Attorney Registration No. 0021324, is suspended from the practice of law in Ohio for an interim period.
