MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2012-0780. Crown Communication, Inc. v. Levin.

Board of Tax Appeals, No. 2009-A-3187. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Board of Tax Appeals.

Upon consideration of appellants' motion for oral argument before the full court, it is ordered by the court that the motion is granted. Oral argument before a master commissioner scheduled for April 2, 2013, is vacated.

2012-1018. Reynoldsburg City School Dist. Bd. of Edn. v. Franklin Cty. Bd. of Revision.

Board of Tax Appeals, No. 2009-A-1161. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Board of Tax Appeals.

Upon consideration of the agreed motion of the parties to remand the appeal in order to implement a settlement, it is ordered by the court that the motion is granted and this cause is remanded to the Board of Tax Appeals so that the board may take further action as appropriate.

It is further ordered that a mandate be sent to the Board of Tax Appeals by certifying a copy of this judgment entry and filing it with the Board of Tax Appeals.

DISCIPLINARY CASES

2010-2126. Disciplinary Counsel v. Grigsby.

On January 18, 2013, respondent, Stephanie Gunter Grigsby, filed an application for termination of probation. Upon consideration thereof, the court finds that respondent has substantially complied with Gov.Bar R. V(9)(D) and with its order dated March 31, 2011, in which the court suspended respondent from the practice of law for a period of 18 months with the entire suspension stayed on the conditions that respondent (1) serve 18 months of supervised probation with a monitor appointed by relator in accordance with Gov.Bar R. V(9) and (2) commit no further misconduct.

On consideration thereof, it is ordered by this court that the probation of respondent, Stephanie Gunter Grigsby, Attorney Registration No. 0070436, last known business address in Piqua, Ohio, is terminated.

It is further ordered that the clerk of this court issue certified copies of this order as provided for in Gov.Bar R. V(8)(D)(1), that publication be made as provided for in Gov.Bar R. V(8)(D)(2), and that respondent bear the costs of publication.
