On Certified Report by the Board of Commissioners on Grievances and Discipline, No. 2013-048. David Charles Eisler, Registration No. 0020362, is suspended from the practice of law in Ohio for two years, with the second year stayed on conditions.

2010-2139. State ex rel. Waters v. Fed. Bur. of Investigation.

In Mandamus. This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of mandamus.

It is ordered by the court, sua sponte, that the parties shall file a notice within 14 days of the date of this entry that indicates whether the proceedings in federal court are still ongoing.

2012-1955. Johnson v. United States Postal Inspection Serv.

In Mandamus and Prohibition. This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of mandamus and prohibition.

On January 10, 2013, this case was stayed pending the resolution of proceedings in federal court. It is ordered by the court, sua sponte, that the parties shall file a notice within 14 days of the date of this entry that indicates whether the proceedings in federal court are still ongoing or whether the proceedings have been completed and the stay in this case may be lifted.
