
E N T R Y

This cause came on for further consideration upon the filing of appellant's motion for order to enforce the court's writ of procedendo or, in the alternative, to declare M.A.D. a vexatious litigator. It is ordered by the court that the motion for order to enforce the court's writ of procedendo is denied, consistent with the opinion rendered herein.

It is further ordered by the court that appellant's motion to declare M.A.D. a vexatious litigator under S.Ct.Prac.R. 4.03(B) is granted. Accordingly, it is ordered that M.A.D. is prohibited from continuing or instituting legal proceedings in this court without first obtaining leave to do so. Any request for leave shall be submitted to the clerk of this court by delivery service, by mail addressed to the Clerk of the Supreme Court of Ohio, or in person for the court's review.

It is further ordered that M.A.D. give notice of this court's decision to the Eighth District Court of Appeals in any matter currently pending or in any appeal or other action instituted in that court by M.A.D.
